Learning Programs

Maroon OEC is a Department of Education school that values learning through community living and active engagement in camping, bushwalking, team building, aquatics and high challenge activities. Programs assist students to develop the Personal and Social Capabilities of Teamwork, Resilience, Connections and Leadership (TRCL) and Critical and the Creative Thinking Capabilities of problem solving and reflection.

Maroon OEC provides bushwalking and camping opportunities to further enhance student growth through experiencing real responsibility. Maroon OEC is committed to the value of campout and this is reflected in prioritising the acceptance of booking applications that include campout.

All <u>programs</u> are collaboratively developed between the school and Maroon OEC. Schools are required to identify one of the <u>core learning areas</u>, which will be the learning focus of the program. Learning opportunities are selected and sequenced to provide the flexibility to respond to the emerging needs of the students and the conditions.

Booking priority is given to Department of Education schools that commit to a 4 or 5 day program including camping as a core activity.

Teamwork, Resilience, Connection or Leadership Adventure Programs:

Students develop and refine their TRCL skills through active engagement in on-site and off-site outdoor activities. Each session is led by a Maroon OEC teacher using an <u>experiential approach</u> designed to assist students to get ready for the activity, participate in the activity and then review their experience.

Every adventure program contains:

- An introductory session to allow the teachers and students to explore individual strengths and capabilities.
- Reflection activities in the final session and at appropriate times during the program.

Five-day adventure programs offer:

• One or two night campouts, team building activities, aquatics and a high challenge experience.

Four-day adventure programs offer:

• One or two night campouts, team building activities and an aquatics OR high challenge experience.

Three-day adventure programs offer:

• On-site team building activities and possibly an aquatics activity.

Leadership Workshop Programs:

These programs integrate school delivered leadership workshops with Maroon OEC's outdoor adventure activities. Schools usually present workshops and activities every night, with some adding sessions for a short period each morning. Subsequent Maroon OEC activity session offers an activity linked to the workshop's learning focus.

Other Programs

Maroon OEC also offers:

- Vocational Education and Training programs for year 10, 11 or 12 students enrolled in a recreation based VET course,
- School curriculum programs for subjects requiring field studies,
- Learning on Country programs exploring Indigenous perspectives.

A separate booking form is available for each of these programs.

Booking Conditions



To maintain our focus on learning and safety we require schools to commit to the following **booking conditions**:

1. Prepare all staff and students for an active, outdoor, educational program.

It is essential that schools work with their Maroon OEC coordinator to prepare the school community for the demands of the program, and provide timely advice to allow for adjustments in program that are responsive to the nature of the school community.

2. Campout

Campout is a rich and real learning experience for staff and students. Maroon OEC is committed to the value of campout and this is reflected in prioritising the acceptance of booking applications that include campout.

3. Distribution of information

Schools must use and distribute all Maroon OEC information to students, parents and teachers. This information allows students, parents / guardians and teachers to make a considered decision regarding their participation in a Maroon OEC program. The school must use our planning process and student management tool as outlined on the camp planning page of the <u>Maroon OEC website</u>.

4. Accompanying Teachers and Adults

Maroon OEC requires schools to bring one teacher for each group of 24 students (24 is the maximum group size) and sufficient extra staff to meet the needs of the students and the demands of the program. Schools are required to bring a minimum of 1 extra teacher who will assume the role of school coordinator. The school coordinator must attend the entire camp program. Schools should bring no more than 2 adults for each group of 24 students except in special circumstances.

5. Co-ordinator Workshop

It is expected that school coordinators for 2023 will participate in the Maroon OEC Coordinator's Workshop. The aim of this workshop is to familiarise teachers with facilities, risk management, operating

procedures, responsibilities and educational opportunities offered through Maroon OEC. The workshop will be conducted in Term 4 2022. Workshop details will be provided to school coordinators in early Term 4, 2022.

6. Accurate Numbers

Maroon OEC conducts its bookings process up to 18 months in advance. We rely on schools to inform us as early as possible of any significant change in student numbers. Final student numbers, medical synopsis and dietary requirements must be provided to the Centre no later than 7 days prior to camp.

7. Fees and Charges

Students are charged a fee for each day, each night and each meal.

- Schools will be charged the full program fee for all students that attend Maroon OEC, unless late arrivals or early departures are advised more than 7 days in advance.
- A Vocational Education and Training fee of \$50/student will be added to VET programs.
- Fees for additional cleaning and damage repairs will be charged to the school if required.
- An administration fee of \$250 will be charged to schools who do not submit final student numbers, medical and dietary information on time.
- Booking deposits and program fees will be direct debited (swept) from the school bank account.

8. Deposit

A deposit of 15% of the total cost of the program is required to be paid before the booking offer is secured. If your school brings fewer students than the booking number, Maroon OEC will retain a corresponding percentage of the deposit. For example: If a school books for 100 students and only 75 attend, 75% of the deposit will be deducted from the invoice total and Maroon OEC will retain 25% of the deposit.

9. Booking Changes and Cancellations

Maroon OEC is to be advised of any requested booking changes or possible cancellations at least 1 full term before camp. Maroon OEC reserves the right to retain the full deposit if your school cancels or requests a change to the number of students or the length of the program. Your school's Principal can apply to the Maroon OEC Principal to refund the deposit in full because of extenuating circumstances.

10. Submission

Booking applications for 2023 will close on Friday 24th June. Booking offers will be made in Term 3, 2022. Successful applicant schools will receive a booking offer, which is secured when the booking offer has been signed by your Principal, returned and the full deposit has been paid.
