Feedback loops enhance teaching and learning, provide motivation and coaching, inspires hope and confidence (Sadler, 1998), enhance a learner's self-evaluative capabilities (Price, Handley & Miller, 2011) and are considered one of the most powerful influences on how people learn (Hattie, 2012). Like a roadmap for the learner and teacher, feedback loops provide evidence, relevance, consequence, and action (Goetz, 2011).
